Vesting Tentative Map for the subdivision of approximately 870 acres into 185 lots, including 168 market rate single family residential lots and 17 lots for moderate income Inclusionary Housing units; three Open Space parcels totaling approximately 700 acres (Parcels A, B, & C), and a parcel for the future development of visitor center (Parcel D); 2) Use Permit for removal of up to 921 protected Oak trees; and 3) Use

Permit for development on slopes exceeding 30 percent.
